Five-bedroom, coral block house, **£1.05 million**

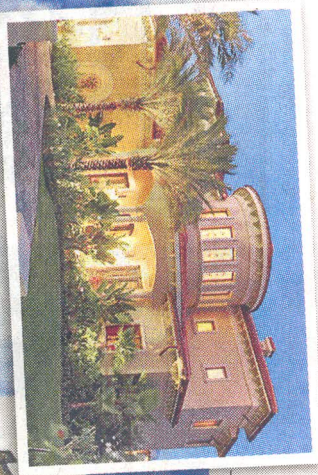
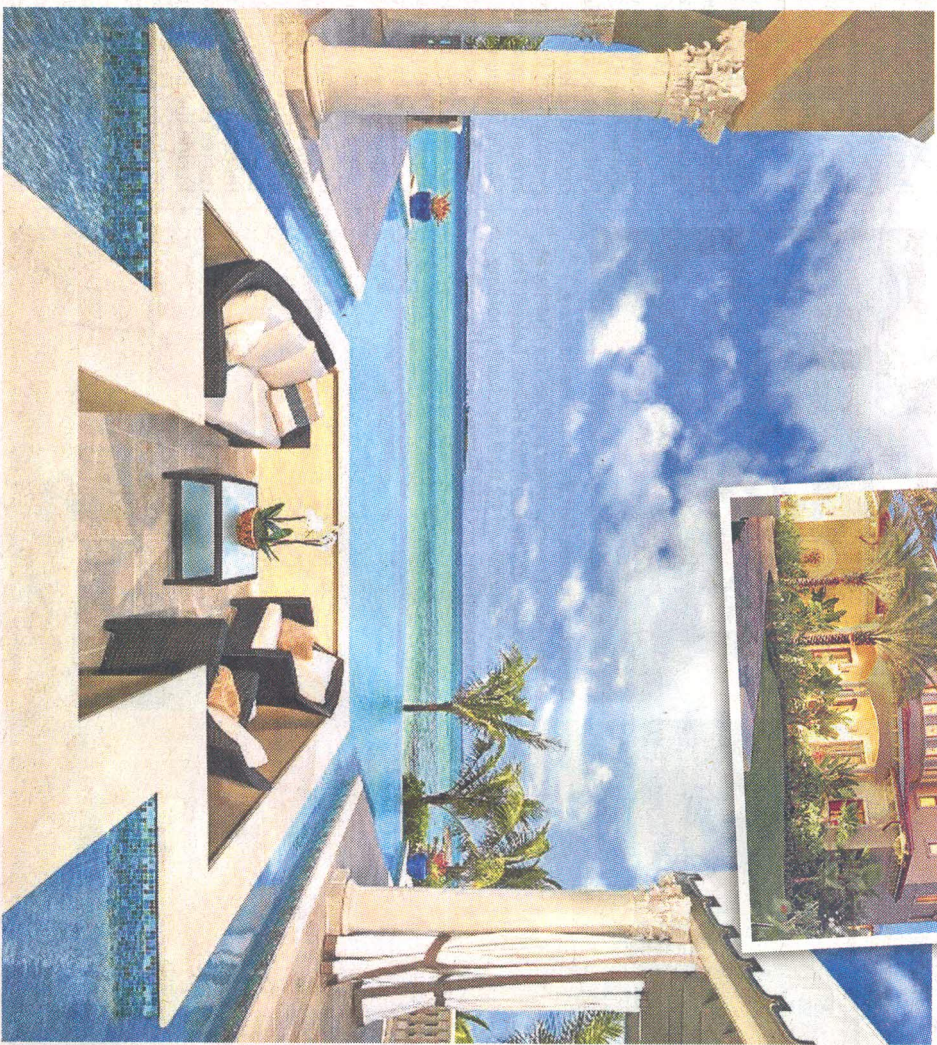
